Tour Descriptions

St. Louis City Tour - Thursday, June 15

It is one of the oldest neighborhoods in the city with homes dating from the mid to late 1800s. We'll stop for lunch in Historic Kimmswick at the Blue Owl Restaurant & Bakery, serving some of the most delicious home-made lunches and bakery items. Lunch will be your choice of 2 out of 5 light lunch options (soup, salad, quiche, sandwich) plus a slice of their famous home-made pie.
